Intended Parent Timeline Checklist

- Visit www.thedonorsolution.com to get started and learn about our program
- Register for Donor Database access by clicking “Find a Donor”
- Receive approval email with link and password to access Donor Database
- Find a few donors you are interested in and send donor numbers to TDS staff to confirm availability and pricing
- Decide on your donor and fill out Recipient Info Sheet
- Sign Fee Schedule and submit 1st installment payment to reserve your egg donor and start your cycle. If travel cycle then submit donor travel deposit as well
- Let your clinic know you have selected a donor with TDS and are starting the process
- Complete any necessary testing at your clinic
- Receive cycle calendar from your clinic
- Sign Agency Agreement, with notary, and submit to TDS staff at least 7 days prior to donor stimulation start
- Remit 2nd installment payment at least 7 days prior to donor stimulation start. TDS staff will send you notice and invoice for this payment once calendar is received from your clinic
- Donor has retrieval!
- If a travel cycle, travel breakdown will be sent you within 30 business days of retrieval along with refund or invoice for any remaining balances.

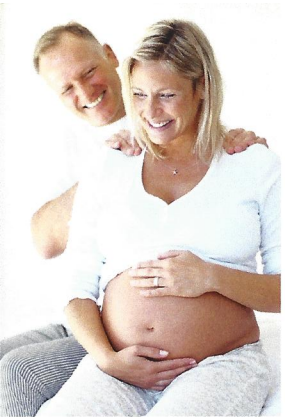

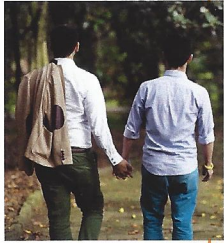

Step 1 - Reasons for Seeking an Egg Donor

Step 2 - Choosing the Right Egg Donor Agency

The egg donor agency you choose can have a direct effect on creating a successful outcome. The Donor Solution is a proud member of the Society for Ethics in Egg Donation and Surrogacy and adheres to all FDA regulations. Our extensive database of donors have all been screened and personally interviewed.

Step 3 - The Initial Consultations

During this consultation, we will discuss any donors that you have found through our database and we will provide detailed information about the donors, photos, and discuss the costs of egg donation.

Step 5 - Egg & Sperm Retrieval

Once you and your donor's cycles are aligned, a minimally invasive egg retrieval procedure is performed to remove the donor's eggs. That same day, the eggs will be fertilized using a specimen from the male partner or sperm donor.

Step 6 - In Vitro Fertilization

Your reproductive endocrinologist will start the in vitro fertilization (IVF) process. When the IVF procedure is successful, the process is combined with a procedure known as embryo transfer, which involves physically placing the embryo in the uterus.

Step 7 - Pregnancy Test

Approximately two weeks after the embryo transfer, a pregnancy test is administered. Hopefully, the IVF treatment was a success and you will be expecting a new addition to your family!

Step 4 - Synchronizing Cycles

Once you have selected an egg donor, our team at The Donor Solution will contact your fertility clinic. During this time both you and the egg donor will receive specific medical instruction regarding administering hormone treatments. This will allow for you and the egg donor to sync cycles for maximum viability of the eggs.
